BALLA 4-year normative degree with a second major in BATI

I. Credit units for a major in BALLA (99 credit units: 54+36+9)

1. BALLA: 54 credit units
 - a. 27 credit units of core courses (9 courses) and
 - b. 27 credit units of electives
2. GE and College courses: 36 credit units (12 courses)
 - a. University English and Chinese cultural requirements: 9 credit units (3 courses);
 - b. Other GE requirements (distributional area): 12 credit units (4 courses);
 - c. College specified courses: 9 credit units (3 courses);
 - d. CLASS requirements: 6 credit units (2 courses)
3. Foundation-year courses: 9 credit units (3 courses)
4. Remaining credit units for BATI courses and other free electives: max. $144-99=45$ credit units
5. BATI courses for a second major: 27 credit units
6. Free electives (optional): $45-27=18$ credit units

II. Minimum number of BATI courses to be taken:

Note: All BATI courses are three credit units, except LT4391 Undergraduate Research Project.

21 credit units of core courses + 6 credit units of B4 electives = 27 credit units (*only if the student has taken LT3326 Comparative Study of Chinese and English and LT4391 Undergraduate Research Project in the BALLA curriculum*)

1. **BATI core courses: 7 courses =21 credit units** (*excluding LT3326 that is a BALLA elective and can be double counted*)

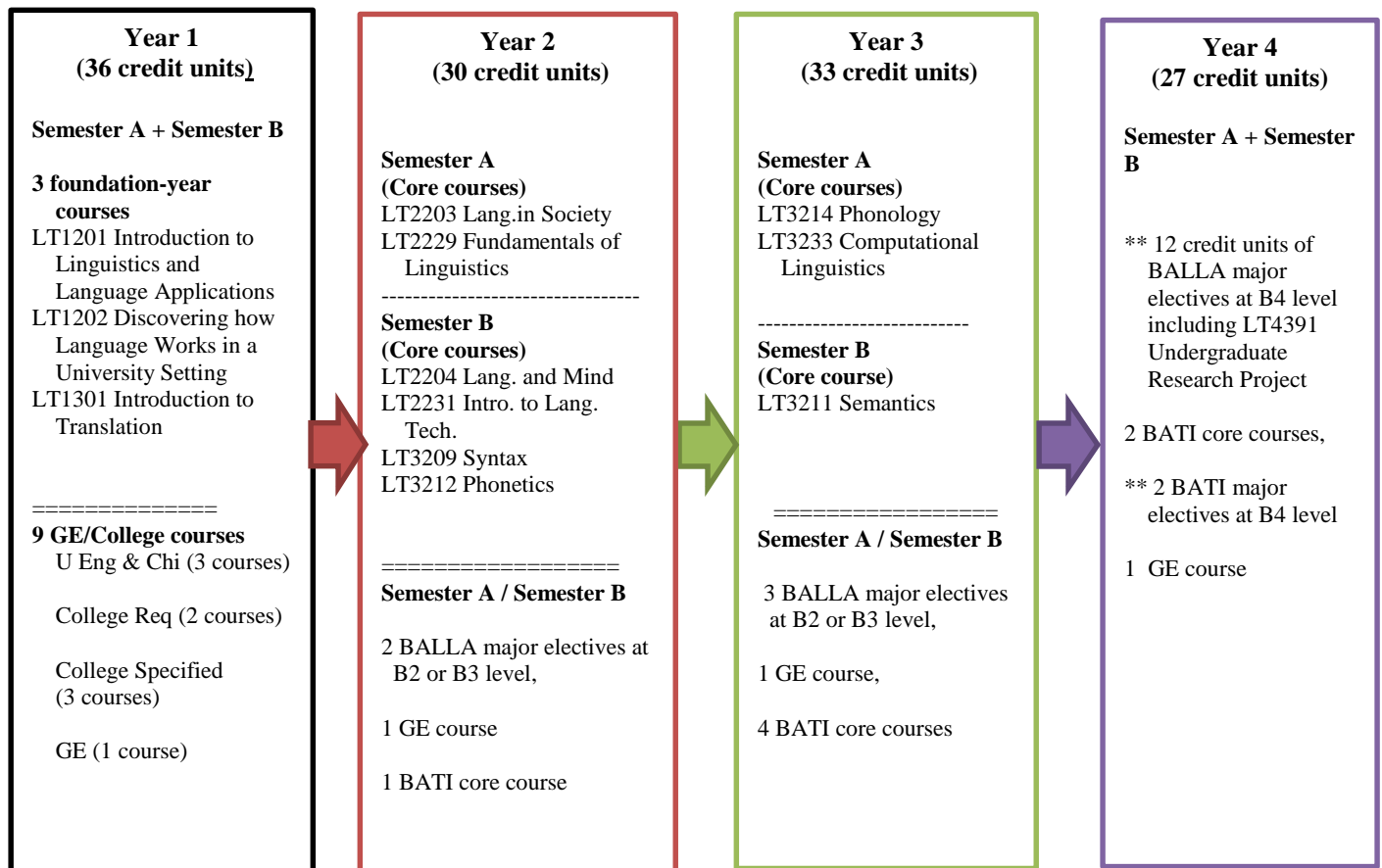

III. Proposed Study plan for normative 4-year students (BALLA+BATI)



Notes:

Apply for double major in Semester A, Year 2 and Start in Semester B, Year 2

Having completed 6 courses per semester in the first three semesters;
 Will continue with 5 or 6 courses per semester in at least 3 out of 5 semesters that remain.

(144 maximum credit units in 4 years = 48 courses in 8 semesters = 6 courses per semester)

Completion of double-major requirement will leave 18 credit units (6 courses) out of the 144 max credit load.
