With placements in public or private sectors, students are expected to gain in-depth and practical understanding of the professional contexts in which they may apply their knowledge and skills related to language.

Period & Duration

Full-time credit-bearing courses
3 credits, 5-6 weeks (May/June – August)
6 credits, 10-12 weeks (May/June – August)

Full-time/Part-time non-credit-bearing course
Maximum length: 12 weeks

The participants are selected students primarily from full-time UGC-funded students who are enrolled in CTL programmes:

- ◆ Bachelor of Arts with Honours in Translation and Interpretation (BATI)
- ◆ Minor in Chinese for Professional Purposes
- ◆ Minor in Japanese Studies
- ◆ Minor in Korean Studies

Priority

The selection priority will be as follows:

Priority 1: CTL-major students

Priority 2: CTL-Japanese Studies or Korean Studies or Chinese for Professional Purposes minor students

Priority 3: Students from other departments who can fulfill the requirements stipulated by the Department
