Notes

1. First-year entrants with Level '4' (or equivalent) or above in HKDSE English Language will proceed to directly into GE English courses.

Students scoring below Level 4 in HKDSE English Language or Grade D in HKALE AS-level Use of English or students who do not possess an equivalent qualification are required to complete 6-credit unit course, EL0200 English for Academic Purposes (EAP), or two 3-credit unit courses, EL0200A English for Academic Purposes 1 and EL0200B English for Academic Purposes 2, prior to taking the GE English courses. Students who demonstrate that they have achieved a grade B or above in their overall course results for EL0200A will achieve 3 credits and also be considered to have satisfied the pre-requisite for entry to the GE English courses without needing to take EL0200B. The credit units of EL0200A and EL0200B will not be counted towards the minimum credit units required for graduation and will not be included in the calculation of the cumulative grade point average (CGPA). However, they will be counted towards the maximum credit units permitted.

2. It is mandatory for students to take one College foundation course per semester during their first year of study. Students admitted to the Department of Linguistics and Translation are not allowed to take LT1101 Amazing Things about Language, which is of the liberal arts studies group, to fulfill the College requirement.
3. Students are required to complete the Department requirement (a total of 9 credit units) in their first year of study.
4. Students are required to complete 12 credit units to satisfy the GE distributional area requirements. They are required to take a minimum of 3 credit units from each of the following areas:
 - Arts and Humanities
 - Study of Societies, Social and Business Organisations
 - Science and Technology
5. Students are required to complete 9 credit units of College-specified courses. They are advised to complete one course in Category I in Year One, one course from Category II in any semester, and one course in either category in any semester.
6. Students scoring below Level 4 in HKDSE Chinese Language, or below Grade D in HKALE AS-level Chinese Language and Culture will be required to complete a 3-credit unit course CHIN1001 University Chinese I. The 3 credit units will not be counted towards the minimum credit units required for graduation and will not be included in the calculation of the cumulative grade point average (CGPA). However, they will be counted towards the maximum credit units permitted. Students are strongly advised to complete CHIN1001 in their first year of study, as far as possible.
7. Major, Department and College requirements should not exceed 72 credit units.

1. The Advanced Standing I students are required to complete 6 credits of GE English comprising GE1401 University English and a Discipline-specific English course.

Students scoring below Level 4 in HKDSE English Language or Grade D in HKALE AS-level Use of English or students who do not possess an equivalent qualification are required to complete 6-credit unit course, EL0200 English for Academic Purposes (EAP), or two 3-credit unit courses, EL0200A English for Academic Purposes 1 and EL0200B English for Academic Purposes 2, prior to taking the GE English courses. Students who demonstrate that they have achieved a grade B or above in their overall course results for EL0200A will achieve 3 credits and also be considered to have satisfied the pre-requisite for entry to the GE English courses without needing to take EL0200B. The credit units of EL0200A and EL0200B will not be counted towards the minimum credit units required for graduation and will not be included in the calculation of the cumulative grade point average (CGPA). However, they will be counted towards the maximum credit units permitted.

2. It is mandatory for students to take one College foundation course per semester during the first year after being admitted to the Department. Students admitted to the Department of Linguistics and Translation are not allowed to take LT1101 Amazing Things about Language, which is of the liberal arts studies group, to fulfill the College requirement.
3. Students are required to satisfy the Department requirement in their first year after being admitted to the Department.
4. Students are required to complete 6 credit units of College-specified courses, 3 credit units from Category I and 3 credit units from Category II.
5. Students scoring below Level 4 in HKDSE Chinese Language, or below Grade D in HKALE AS-level Chinese Language and Culture will be required to complete a 3-credit unit course CHIN1001 University Chinese I. The 3 credit units will not be counted towards the minimum credit units required for graduation and will not be included in the calculation of the cumulative grade point average (CGPA). However, they will be counted towards the maximum credit units permitted.
6. Students are required to complete 6 credit units to satisfy the GE distributional area requirements in any of the following areas:
 - Arts and Humanities
 - Study of Societies, Social and Business Organisations
 - Science and Technology
7. Major, Department and College requirements should not exceed 72 credit units.
