5. Eligibility Criteria

For existing Year 1 students:

- (i) Top 10% of Year 1 students of CLASS and a minimum CGPA at 3.4 at the end of Year 1 Semester B; and
- (ii) Completion of at least 30 credit units in Semesters A and B, including the number of credit units specified by the College/home academic units of required courses.

Academic standard required for on-going performance in Undergraduate (UG) study:

Required to maintain a yearly CGPA (at the end of Semester B) at 3.4 or above

Conditions of offer for admission to Taught Postgraduate (TPG) Programme

- (i) completion of the required TPG courses (9 credit units) specified in the UG curriculum;
- (ii) final-year CGPA for the Bachelor's Degree Award at 3.4 or above; and
- (iii) satisfying the specific programme entrance requirements set by the offering department of the TPG programme if applicable.

Approval of entry into and exit from the Talents Programme will be processed in accordance with University rules and policies. Once exited, a student cannot re-join the Programme in later semester or year.

9 credit units of TPG courses will be taken in final year of the UG curriculum and will be transferred from the UG to the TPG curriculum.
